Due: April 3, 2023


Amount allowed per project: \$100,000

Overview of funding request: Creation of outdoor classrooms and pollinator gardens



Funding source: Department of Energy (DOE))

Schools included: District-wide request

Full application: Our concept paper was short-listed from 1,000+ applications, nationally

Due: April 21, 2023

Amount requested: \$4.685M (~91% would be funded by DOE, ~9% funded by District)

Overview of funding request: Seven improvements across all eight schools that would improve the District's energy efficiency and improved air quality

Timeline: If funded, the improvements would occur across FY '24-FY '26
